

## Who Uses: **Show-Stopper Texturized Show Cattle Ration (500312)**

Producers who wish to feed a premium show cattle ration. Purebred breeders fitting cattle for sale and 4-H groups would benefit from the use of this ration.

### Description

**Show-Stopper Texturized Show Cattle Ration** is a 14% protein texturized ration intended to be fed up to 5 kg per head per day. It is a concentrated formula of selected ingredients, containing high levels of quality protein, minerals and vitamins intended to produce a shiny, healthy hair-coat.

### Features

- Contains 14% crude protein with rumen undegradable (UIP) protein. Features AminoPlus bypass soymeal.
- Selected ingredients and consistent formulation. All vegetable-based ration.
- Higher energy.
- Contains vegetable oil and linseed oil meal.
- Contains Zinpro.
- Highly fortified with minerals and vitamins.
- Texturized (rolled grains, molasses) ration.
- Contains Yea-sacc.
- Made with Beet Pulp.

- High level of protein of high bypass value and with an optimum amino acid profile. Young, lean, growthy cattle have higher requirements for bypass protein of optimum amino acid balance.

- Helps improve growth and resistance to stress and disease.

### Feeding Recommendations

**Growing heifers:** Provide **Show-Stopper Texturized Show Cattle Ration** at 0.5 to 1.25 kg per 100 kg bodyweight per head per day.

**Growing steers & bulls:** Provide **Show-Stopper Texturized Show Cattle Ration** at 0.75 to 1.5 kg per 100 kg bodyweight per head per day.

**Adult cattle:** Provide **Show-Stopper Texturized Show Cattle Ration** at up to 5 kg per head per day.

**Show-Stopper Texturized Show Cattle Ration** should be fed along with good quality forage and/or pasture and a free-choice source of salt and minerals and vitamins. Adjust the feeding rate as required to achieve the desired rate of growth and level of body condition.

**Provide a free choice source of salt, minerals and vitamins, and fresh, clean water at all times.**

**GROWING HEIFERS:** FEED MASTERFEEDS SHOW-STOPPER AT 0.5 TO 1.25 KG PER 100 KG BODY WEIGHT PER DAY.

**GROWING STEERS AND BULLS:** FEED MASTERFEEDS SHOW-STOPPER AT 0.75 TO 1.5 KG PER 100 KG BODY WEIGHT PER DAY.

**ADULT CATTLE:** FEED MASTERFEEDS SHOW-STOPPER AT UP TO 5 KG PER HEAD PER DAY.

MASTERFEEDS SHOW-STOPPER SHOULD BE FED ALONG WITH GOOD QUALITY FORAGE AND/OR PASTURE AND A FREE CHOICE SOURCE OF SALT AND SUPPLEMENTAL MINERALS AND VITAMINS. ADJUST THE FEEDING RATE OF MASTERFEEDS SHOW-STOPPER AS REQUIRED TO ACHIEVE THE DESIRED RATE OF GROWTH AND LEVEL OF BODY CONDITION.
